Part 1: Semi-Direct Part

18 randomly generated questions from the dedicated language assessment platform's question bank

Duration: approx. 25 minutes

Question Types:

- 1. General questions (e.g. What initially drew you to aviation?)
- 2. Technical questions (e.g. What are the necessary checks to be performed before a flight?)
- 3. ICAO phraseology and alphanumerics (e.g. Spelling the ICAO phonetic alphabet and numbers)
- 4. ATIS comprehension and radio communications (e.g. Clearance readback)
- 5. Image description (e.g. A photo of an aircraft landing / a flight path)

Part 2: Interview with the Examiner

A one-on-one conversation with the examiner.

Duration: approx. 10–15 minutes

Common Topics:

- The candidate's aviation background
- Training and career motivations
- Personal preferences related to aviation subjects

Please Note:

- 1. Questions are personalized based on the candidate's position (Aircraft Pilot fixed wing/rotary wing or ATC) and level (Student or Professional).
- 2. Factual errors (e.g. Incorrectly identifying an aircraft type) do not negatively affect your rating.
- 3. Respond in full, cohesive sentences unless special phraseology is required.
